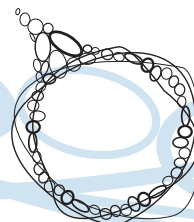

## Interruption to Electricity Supply

We have received communication from United Energy advising us that there will be an interruption to our Electricity Supply on Sunday 1 May from 8am till 4pm. This power interruption will include the Library, Novotel, Monash Council and some surrounding houses and shops.

Property is in discussion with United Energy to see if there are any options available to us, but we must start planning for no power on that Sunday. Specifically this will affect 8am, 9.15am and 11am worship.

No power means no lights, no fridge usage, no food to be left in fridge, freezer to be left shut all day, no broadcast or recordings, no organ, no keyboard and band, no hot water for tea, coffee or washing, no tank pumps for toilets, no Club 2016 food or drink heating.
