4.30 worship – Term 3 speakers for Adult Discussion Group

Our theme for the term is Joshua and our focus verse is "**Do not be terrified, do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go" Joshua 1:9.** In the Adult Discussion Group time of our 4.30 pm worship, we are having some inspiring speakers and we welcome you to come and join us. Invite your friends to come and hear some everyday Christians share of how God has been with them in their journey. The speakers will speak for 45 minutes from 5.00 pm to 5.45 pm but you are welcome to come to the whole service which goes from 4.30 pm and finishes with dinner for \$2 at 6.00 pm.

This Sunday 1 Aug - God with us in depression and cancer. Penny Hayes is an enthusiastic, positive, incredibly strong mum whose faith story will inspire you as she shares how God has been with her in her journey with depression, cancer and then in becoming a mum in her 40's.

Sunday 8 August - God with us in the everyday work that we do. Steve Lowe is a down to earth accountant who felt called to leave a highly paid but stressful job to sort out some things in his life and to use his accounting to help others. He now works for a number of not for profit organisations and helps individuals sort out their finances. He is passionate about preventing people and organisations getting into financial difficulty. Steve will share how God has been with him through all he has done.

Sunday 15 August - God with us in our baptism and confirmation. Some of our young confirmees and baptismal candidates will share with us what brought them to the decision to be confirmed or baptised and how God is working in their life. Be inspired by some of the amazing young people that we are privileged to have as part of our congregation.

Sunday 12 September - God with us in the tragedy of Black Saturday and in the journey afterwards. At the time of Black Saturday Anthony Stokes was living on 500 acres in Upper Plenty. His parents also had a house on this property. Anthony's wife was 8 months pregnant as was his brother's wife. On Black Saturday Anthony, his parents, his brother Matthew and a family friend fought valiantly to fight the ferocious fires that tore through their valley. Anthony's father was killed but he, his mother, brother and family friend all miraculously survived. Anthony and his father's livelihood were their orchards which were all lost in the fires along with their homes and all that they had. Anthony's family were well known for their faith in their local community and beyond. What happens to your faith when you go through something like that? Anthony will share how God has been with them.
