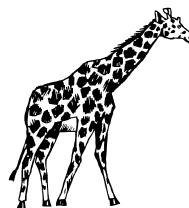

### How to update the Web and Wiki sites.

Our web site, gwuc.org.au, is the primary way that new people, and especially younger people, find out about us. It was rebuilt last year to make the front page focus on the current news, in order to give the site more immediacy and appeal. It was also built to simplify updating of the current news, enabling accredited group representatives to post news themselves, thus keeping the site current. We now need to train and accredit people for this job.

We have also set up a Wiki for internal communications. A Wiki is even easier to update, and has very flexible permissions, enabling individual pages to be seen and modified by specific people, such as a specific committee.

This Monday, 8 February at 8.00 pm, will be our first training session in these two communication tools. If you would like to be able to update material for your group, you are welcome to come. We are especially keen to have the Missional Groups and other major committees represented by the most appropriate person who is available. We will have instructions, computers to try with, and people to help.
