Meeting of the Congregation

A Special Meeting of the Congregation will be held in the Worship Centre at 8pm on Monday 8 November 2010 to receive and resolve upon a recommendation from the Joint Nominating Committee to issue a call to a Minister to fill the vacant placement at Glen Waverley.

The meeting is in response to the decision made by the Congregation on 12 April 2010 to appoint a Joint Nominating Committee to seek initially one full time Minister of the Word, and is the final stage of the process described by Rev Greg Crowe, Chairman of the Joint Nominating Committee, at the meeting of the Congregation on 5 July 2010.

The recommendation of the JNC is the only matter to be considered at this meeting.

ELECTION OF CHURCH COUNCILLORS

UCA Regulations require the Congregation to form a Church Council "to build up the Congregation in faith and love, sustain members in hope, and lead the Congregation to a fuller

participation in Christ's mission in the world." Our Council is comprised by twenty-five elected members and the ministers *ex officio*. At present our Council has seven vacant positions that need to be filled. The term of office is from one to five years as is determined by the candidate.

Kerryn Leister has completed her present term but is eligible to be nominated again. Roger Vass is a co-opted member until the end of 2010 and he also is eligible to be nominated and elected by the Congregation. We are very grateful to Kerryn and Roger for their commitment of time and energy to serve us all.

An election to fill the vacancies will be held at all worship services on 22 November.2010. Nominations can be accepted until midday on Wednesday 10 November. Nomination forms are available from Wendy in the Church Office. The names of candidates will be announced in the *Bulletin* on Sunday 14 November

It is important that the Council has a full range of the God-given gifts and services that are available within our Congregation. Please consider and pray for and talk to members whom you discern as people who might become Church Councillors. Encourage them to nominate.
