ELECTION OF CHURCH COUNCILLORS

UCA Regulations require the Congregation to form a Church Council "to build up the Congregation in faith and love, sustain members in hope, and lead the Congregation to a fuller

participation in Christ's mission in the world." Our Council is comprised by twenty-five elected members and the ministers *ex officio*. At present our Council has seven vacant positions that need to be filled. The term of office is from one to five years as is determined by the candidate.

Kerryn Leister has completed her present term but is eligible to be nominated again. Roger Vass is a co-opted member until the end of 2010 and he also is eligible to be nominated and elected by the Congregation. We are very grateful to Kerryn and Roger for their commitment of time and energy to serve us all.

An election to fill the vacancies will be held at all worship services on 28 November 2010. Nominations can be accepted until midday on Wednesday 17 November. Nomination forms are available from Wendy in the Church Office. The names of candidates will be announced in the *Bulletin* on Sunday 21 November

It is important that the Council has a full range of the God-given gifts and services that are available within our Congregation. Please consider and pray for and talk to members whom you discern as people who might become Church Councillors. Encourage them to nominate.

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CONGREGATION

Last Monday evening one hundred members met and agreed unanimously to invite Rev. Rosemary Carter to join the ministry team at Glen Waverley. Rosemary will conclude her chaplaincy at Uniting Care Moreland Hall shortly and expects to begin her ministry with us on 1st February 2011.



Rosemary's husband Rev. David Carter ministers at Glen Iris Uniting Church. They have two adult children.

Rosemary has degrees in Theology and Social Work and is a registered nurse. Rosemary was ordained in 1996, after which she had two team ministry placements in Adelaide, South Australia.

During that time Rosemary was involved with the SA Council of Churches and the Synod of SA Social Justice Commission.

An office-bearer from a previous congregation said of Rev. Carter that "She places high importance on the preparation and delivery of worship, and she can lead both innovative and traditional styles. A strength is her pastoral leadership — she attends to people. Rosemary is a team player. She is consultative and works for consensus decisions."

Rev Carter told the Joint Nominating Committee that her relationship with God is central – she has confidence that she is loved, accepted and free. She believes that through the life and ministry of Jesus we see how to act and respond in ways that express God's love in the world, and is convinced that the Spirit witnesses through the prophets, Jesus and all people of faith throughout the ages.

We welcome Rosemary as she joins Greg and Alanee in team ministry and, with them, leads us in mission and service to the people of Glen Waverley.
