# COMMUNITY OUTREACH GROUP

## October 2010

You may not have heard that we have changed the Group's name again, to **Community Outreach**, as some people thought it more appropriate (and shorter).

By the time you read this you will have shared in the **2010 Fete** and had a great time in raising money for this year's COP (Congregational Outreach Projects) and sharing together in community, fun and fellowship. This year's Projects are again featured on our Noticeboard at the top of the ramp in the foyer.

For those of you who are continuing to fill shoeboxes for **Operation Christmas Child** (as we did during Outreach Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> July, and which the Playgroups are continuing to do) please return those boxes to Rebecca & Peter (at the Fair Trade Stall in the Foyer between the 9:00 and 11:00am Services), Alanee or Wendy in the Office by **20 October** latest otherwise they will miss being sent to children this Christmas!

You may have noticed the **Kenya 2009-2010** book has now been reprinted and copies are available if you have previously ordered them. If you haven't ordered one, be quick and you may be fortunate to buy one at \$20. The Kenya Outreach Group has another lovely publication for sale coming soon - an Africa calendar. It will be a great gift idea for Christmas. Again see Rebecca and Peter at the Fair trade Stall. The money raised from these sales is for use when the Kenya Outreach Group sees needs during their stay this 2010-2011 season. In case you don't know the facts, this money does NOT go towards the fares and expenses of those going to Kenya. They each pay in the order of \$3,500 to cover their own air/land fares and living costs in Kenya!

Imagine that. If say 10 people go to Kenya that's combined expenses of \$35,000 BEFORE they start spending on needs in Kenya any of the COP or other money raised. The money that this Group currently has available (including COP money) to take and use in Kenya totals only about \$5,100 which is a rather small amount compared to their expenses. You may want to give this some personal thought and talk to Alanee & Joel, Kat & Jason or Sarah (some of the team going back this season).

What a privilege we had last Sunday to hear and meet John Gusmao, a friend from Baguia. John spoke about the water projects and gave his thanks for GWUC's support. *That's feedback for you!* 

We previously stated in the Bulletin that the money raised by **Tanks for Timor**, plus a subsequent generous donation from Rotary Melbourne, will enable us to install water tanks, toilet and sanitation facilities at primary schools in Gulari, Ossofulari and Bubuha villages ie 3 NOT just 1 village.
