2010 - Sammy Stamp has done it again!

Done what - you may ask!

Achieved another productive and rewarding year!

Sales, up to and including 9 December, have reached about \$22,949 (last year \$2,943), with today's sales to add.

Total sales since 1977 amount to approximately \$579,011.

Thanks to all the volunteers who come in regularly on Thursdays (average attendance 23.5 from a pool of around 40 persons).

Thanks also to those scattered church groups, individuals and firms throughout Victoria and Tasmania and other States who collect, trim and/or sort untold numbers of stamps etc for the UCAF Stamp Fund (Sammy Stamp) so that many worthy causes can be supported.

Below is a list of grants approved by Sammy Stamp during 2010, totalling \$22,800. (Last year \$27,635). It is of interest to note that even though the amount granted in 2010 is less, there were 18 grants compared to 12 last year.
