

Submissions can be anonymous, however including your name will allow us to contact you if there are any issues which we might need to follow up with you.



Flood Relief

Pam and I are visiting Horsham this weekend and staying with our 'new' farming friends Fran & Barry Robinson. Since the visit to their farm in late February by Margaret, Steven, Ken, Don and ourselves to assist with a small amount of clean-up work, Barry has had Ross River fever. The treatment is REST so we haven't encouraged any others of you to join this visit because of Barry's condition.

We will lunch with Rev Jen and Bill Pretty (good friends of ours) on the way up to Horsham. Following her time as Minister at Beeac, Jen is now Western Victoria Presbytery Minister for Mission & Education and it was she who provided the contacts for me at Horsham, and Donald.

We hope to meet the couple again out of Horsham whose house was inundated with flood water at which Margaret, Pam and Fran did some cleaning and perhaps more importantly, showed that "they cared". The money donated by you and given to Horsham Uniting Church will be used to assist this couple.

Have you read the current (April) Crosslight, page 8 *After the Flood?* You'll read about the work that both John Russell at Donald and Dennis Davies (not Davison) at Charlton, are doing and they are my contacts in these places. We hope to meet John and Dennis on Sunday – we've only spoken by phone or email up to now. There is much relief work still being done in these towns. The money donated by you to St Andrews Uniting Church Donald now totalling \$1,117, is being used on programmes to assist the people of Charlton.

In addition to all the goods you have donated up to now we are taking with us 8 "Pamper Packs" (just imagine what they are? Of course they are just for women) some double sheet sets, men's work trousers and jumpers and two double doonas.

In an email from Dennis this morning (Wednesday) he tells of how busy he continues to be in this relief work and acknowledges the arrival of the second truckload of goods from GWUC ..."thanks again for the organizing of the furniture and goods; they are much appreciated by the people receiving them. I know how much effort is involved as it is somewhat replicated this end also." So to those of you who did donate goods, please accept this acknowledgement from Charlton.

We hope to have more to report to you after our visit.
