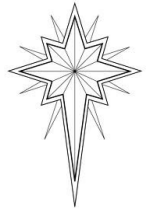

FLOOD RELIEF

I spoke to my contact, Susan, at Horsham Uniting Church on Thursday just to 'touch base'.

She is still talking about physical assistance on a particular farm; cleaning up fence lines etc.

There is likely to be room for 'our' caravans. Power provided. Toilets and cooking facilities would be provided in a cottage but all these details still have to be confirmed. It's still 10 days to 2 week off before it would be appropriate for us to go there.

I haven't heard any more directly from Donald re Charlton other than that my contact is extremely busy!

Habitat for Humanity "Brush with Kindness Bushfire Response" **Saturday February 19th.**

For this project we will travel to the Flowerdale region (north of Hazeldeane where some of us worked last year, which is north of Kinglake). We will be helping to clear a block which has fallen trees and re-growth after the fire, as well as other debris around the block.

There will be brush cutting and chainsaw work, so if anyone has this equipment it would be helpful if you could bring them along.

We will car pool as usual from GWUC car park.
