#### **FETE 2011**

Yet again our Fete last Saturday was fantastic for all the right reasons. We want to echo Rosemary Carter's comments at last Sunday's services in thanking the Fete Committee (Cliff Baker, Yan Emms, Judy Fry, Murray Lowe and Faye Wagon) for their years work planning, organising and running the Fete. (Please read the Committee Report.)

The six COP projects approved by July 2011 Congregational Meeting will be funded from the Fete Proceeds:-

- \* Friends of Baguia Salaries for Kinder teachers: \$3,600
- Habitat A tool trailer supporting the "Brush with Kindness Bushfire Response Program: \$4,500
- \* Hotham Mission Asylum Seekers Project emergency accommodation rental costs for placing Asylum Seekers in safe accommodation until permanent housing becomes available: \$2,500
- \* "Mission in Action" Kenya Design, materials and labour for children's playground: \$7,400
- New Hope Counselling Workshops for Anger Management, Grief and Loss: \$1.500
- \* Rubaga Youth Development Secondary schooling and vocational training to children who would otherwise be in slavery conditions: \$500

Better still is that the Projects conditional on the fete raising over \$20,000 will receive some funding:-

- Kids Hope will receive funding towards affiliation fees: \$300
- Friends of Ermera, East Timor is likely to receive close to the \$4,000 recommended.

Total amount needed to fund the above, \$24,300 against the provisional Fete total nett figure of \$24,000 as at Sunday 16 October.

It is planned that presentations to the projects will occur in the next Month!


## Combined Service - Sunday 30th October
