### OPPORTUNITY FOR FUNDRAISING FOR ASYLUM SEEKERS.

Over the past few years GWUC members have generously contributed to fund-raising for Hotham Mission ASP, by assisting with the Whitehorse Community Chest. By either 'walking' (delivering brochures to letter-boxes) or 'collecting' (door-knocking to ask for donations), on a formula of one collector = 4 walkers, we assisted the Outer Eastern Asylum Support Network in gaining a portion of the Whitehorse Community Chest funds to go towards housing support of homeless asylum seekers. The more people we put in the field, the greater our slice of the pie! Last year, together with other churches supporting the Network, Hotham ASP was granted \$5780 through this appeal.

# Assessment Criteria for Congregational Outreach Projects (COP) 2011

### Criteria

The following criteria help the COP Selection Panel draw up a short list of Projects to recommend to the Congregation.

- That we donate the funds that we raise as a response to Christ's commission to His Church. Our aim is to follow the example of Jesus in providing practical assistance to needy people in our world.
- 2. That we support Projects that are within the spirit of the UCA mission.
- 3. That we ensure any Project is:

openly accountable to the public; viable; managed by trustworthy people; and meets appropriate legal requirements.

- 4. That our preference is to support ministries in which we as a Congregation have some personal contact through our members who are engaged in them. In this way we can be kept involved and informed about their work.
- 5. That each submission comprises a completed COP Application Form 2011 and any supporting information.

### **Chairs for Timor**

On the 12 March the chairs donated by Scotch College, and temporarily stored in the church manse garage, were transported to a Rotary International warehouse in West Footscray ready for shipping to East Timor. It took five very full trailers and many helping hands to get the job done. These chairs will be distributed among schools and the community centre in Baguia, East Timor, where many such facilities remain unfurnished – they will be greatly appreciated! Big thanks to all who lent their time and trailers in the organisation and transport of this worthwhile effort.

### Victorian Flood Relief

Many of the items you donated have not only been transported to Charlton last Sunday, but were being given to those in most need by Monday – how fast is that! The truck was about 75% full when it arrived to load goods collected at GWUC. We hope to ship a further batch of goods already collected to Charlton yesterday subject to truck space being available.

Thank you to all of you who have contributed so far!

We are arranging now to send your monetary donations as a cheque of \$750 to St Andrews Uniting Church, Donald for use in Charlton, plus a cheque of \$620 to Horsham Uniting Church for specific use towards a flood damaged home.

Lastly, we are in the early stages of planning another "working bee" trip to Horsham again to assist tidying up farm land after the floods. The proposed dates (revised) are Thursday 8 April to Tuesday 12 April. There is limited accommodation at the farm but ample room for caravans.
