FLOOD RELIEF VICTORIA


We have been in touch with (Rev) Jen Pretty (late of Beaac Uniting Church) now a Presbytery Minister for Western Victoria, suggesting our Church might be able to provide some physical help. Jen put us in contact with John Russell. Minister at Donald Uniting Church, who is providing support in the area. The worst affected area is Charlton, 20 minutes drive 40 km from Donald. Donald Church has provided about \$6,000 (unbudgeted) worth of food and care packages and now is providing bedding and small electrical items to those in need. We are awaiting advice from John as to what items we might be able to donate.

The Shire Council (Buloke Shire) is coordinating help in the area. We are now included on their data base and awaiting their advice of specific work and locations. Charlton has NO accommodation, but Donald has an operating Caravan Park with powered sites AND some cabins.

If you *might* be able to assist with work and/or goods please add your name to the contact list on the Office window to assist us in promptly contacting you when the needs are known
