In 2012 our church community directly raised more than \$4500 for the work of Hotham Mission Asylum Seeker Project: \$3000 from the GWUC fete (which went towards the rental of a unit in Heathmont for a family), \$1500 from a concert given by Free Spirit choir and donations from the Honey Money. In addition, GWUC provided walkers to drop leaflets in letterboxes, and collectors, for the Whitehorse Community Chest fund raiser which resulted in a grant of \$7968 to Hotham Mission ASP. We also donated more than 85 items of household linen, 1440 items of clothing, 148 items of food, 16 toiletry items, and 15 household cleaning items for needy arrivals.

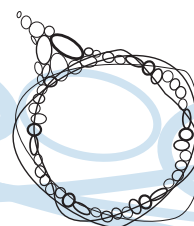
