Congregational Meeting - 2 September 2018.

Dear Friends,

In the June monthly bulletin, we read the following note from Church Council - "earnings of the (endowment) fund can be used for particular ministries and mission projects." Groups within the church were invited to put in submissions that comply with the Endowment Fund rules (found at <u>http://wiki.gwuc.org.au/gwuc/EndowmentFundRules2018</u>). Earnings amount to \$10,000.

Inclusive Community / Pastoral Care Committee submitted a proposal to Church Council to install a large freezer (Westinghouse 425 litre vertical freezer with adjustable glass shelves and freezer baskets). When we purchase the freezer, its installation will require some modifications in the kitchen.

Pastoral Care is a ministry in itself and Pastoral Care and Hospitality are integral parts of our mission within our church family and in the community. They foster care, friendship and fellowship.

An efficient larger freezer would help our committee, the Hub, Leisure Time and other groups that use our kitchen facilities to provide better services and store items such as ice-cream, casseroles and desserts. We would also be able to offer a greater variety of food, store supplies for emergency pastoral situations and gluten free bread for communion. The chest freezer that we are using at present doesn't have the capacity to hold these items and also needs frequent defrosting. We have spoken to some people involved in these groups and they are excited that there will be better facilities for storing frozen items, once this submission is approved.

Property Committee, the Careful Kitchen Crew and Church Council support this purchase and the necessary renovations. We are asking for \$3,000. This would adequately cover the cost of the freezer and materials for the modifications necessary in the kitchen.

We need congregational approval to use the earnings of the Endowment Fund as well as Church Council and these other groups, mentioned above. We would seek your approval today so that the renovations in the kitchen can be started and we can purchase the freezer and start using it.
