#### Acknowledgement of Australia's First Peoples

At an open meeting on Sunday 16 June to consider how we might acknowledge Australia's first peoples, it was decided that an appropriate next step is to place a plaque outside the church, where it is visible to passers-by, containing the following. "We the Glen Waverley Congregation of the Uniting Church in Australia acknowledge that the land on which we gather is part of the traditional lands of the Kulin nation. We respect the close spiritual and cultural ties of Australia's first people to the land, and recognise elders past, present and emerging. We commit to work for reconciliation with indigenous people and justice for all." The location of the plaque will be further discussed with the Property Committee. Formal ratification of the statement will be sought at a meeting of the congregation on July 28th. John Snare, Chair of the Congregation.
