

In his welcome to our team members Craig Mitchell wrote:


"I'm delighted that you're on board for our 2020 Mission Pilot initiative. Both myself and the presbytery team look forward to working with you in the coming year in identifying and exploring a new mission initiative. I trust that God will lead us into fresh possibilities and renewed hope."

Our team is made up of Ryan Chan, Anne Cook, Mark Easton, Anne Newton, Rev. Neil Peters and Daniel Sihombing. They will be presented to the congregation on March 1st at the combined worship.

The Mission Cultivation Process is a twelve-month process for congregations to learn about new ways of being in mission through action learning – taking on a new initiative and learning from the experience. This involves a process of missional cultural change designed to assist congregations to respond to the challenges and opportunities of the post-Christendom context in Australia.
