## *How to come to Church on Sundays...*

### **Option 1:**

1. Open the Internet on your computer, iPad or device
2. Go to the Glen Waverley Uniting Church website - [www.gwuc.org.au](http://www.gwuc.org.au)
3. Click on the **Worship Live Stream** box
4. Move your mouse over the picture of the church and when the arrow in the middle highlights red, click the arrow.

### **Option 2:**

Open YouTube and search for **Glen Waverley Uniting Church** to find our YouTube channel.

*Services/Events go 'Live' 5 minutes before the start time*

### **Mount Waverley Chadstone Inter-Church Council - the Way of the Cross**

*The Way of the Cross* will be live-streamed using Facebook from the Mount Waverley Chadstone Inter-Church Council Facebook page which can be found at: <https://fb.me/mwicc> or search Facebook for MWCICC.

If you don't have internet access, you can join the Way of the Cross using Zoom on a telephone (either landline or mobile) by dialling in on Good Friday from 11.10am (for an 11.15am start). First, call the Zoom local number (03) 7018 2005. Next, when the call connects you will be prompted to enter the meeting number, which is 930 421 677, and press the # key.

Once you've entered that number you'll hear what's happening, or be asked to wait if it hasn't started yet. It's that simple!.
