

School Chaplaincy

A Bill has been submitted to the Victorian Parliament by Fiona Patten (Reason Party) which aims to remove the religious nature of school chaplaincy and force schools to employ secular youth workers. Currently a school can choose to appoint a chaplain, a youth worker, a nurse or none. The Bill will sideline Chaplaincy providers. The Bill will be debated soon. - Make sure the final design fits within a 20cm by 20cm square, leaving a 2.5cm border on all sides

Church Council News

Due to current social distancing requirements relating to church buildings, no meetings will be held at the church during this time. **The complex remains closed, and online worship will continue throughout October.**

Sharing Good News: Ministerial transitions and future strategy

Over some months Church Council has worked through the following process with a minimum 5 year timeframe:

- 1. Affirm Direction and Priorities.
- 2. Where do we need paid roles in line with strategic direction?
- 3. Where can we work with volunteers to meet strategic direction?
- 4. What does our financial position say to us?
- 5. Affirm staffing needs?
- 6. Affirm who will fill roles or how we fill roles?

Back in July, Council affirmed the Organic Vision that arose from a deeply engaged process back in 2014 (http://wiki.gwuc.org.au/gwuc/OnePageVision2014).

At our August meeting, realising that unfortunately it is not possible to keep Neil working forever, Council agreed that as we look to the future and our commitment to live out our vision, we continue to prioritise our ministerial staffing, with an emphasis on ensuring continuity. Council has affirmed a transition process with Neil's anticipated retirement in something like three years' time, to try to ensure we have a Minister of the Word at GWUC prior to Neil concluding.

At Wednesday's meeting we unanimously took another important step forward:

... Council gratefully acknowledges Alanee for her faithful, creative and inspiring ministry and affirms its desire to extend Alanee's appointment for a further 5 years.

Following the usual practice, the congregation will be asked to affirm this at the next Congregational Meeting.

At the same time, recognising their wonderful contributions, Council has also asked People and Culture Committee to extend the contracts of Di Paterson and Joanne Boldiston and to carry forward Jemma Graham's Children and Families role into 2021.

Council also approved in principle the recruitment of a part time welfare coordinator funded from the Gwenda Henry bequest.

There are still many steps to take, but these are vital decisions for our future vision and mission. Finally, let me share with you the challenge Alanee put to Church Council in August:

As we find ourselves in this peculiar time in the life of our church community, I propose we take the opportunity to explore, research, dream and discern future opportunities.

And time to dream and explore the new unimagined opportunities of church community that we have found ourselves faced with at this time.

If you look at the minutes of Church Council, with reports from groups and individuals, you will see how this process has begun and the initiatives which already are being explored.
