Church Council News

Due to current social distancing requirements relating to church buildings, no meetings will be held at the church during this time. The complex remains closed, and online worship will continue throughout November.

Re-opening Task Group

On behalf of the church council, the re-opening task group met this week to look at the steps we can take to begin to return to the church building for worship and other activities.

From Sunday 15 November we will introduce live music (rather than pre-recorded) into the live streaming worship with a small number of musicians in the church. We will also look at having live organ/piano music played before the live stream at 10am.

What subsequently becomes possible depends on the number of cases in Melbourne. According to the current definition of the Roadmap (<u>https://www.coronavirus.vic.gov.au/sites/</u><u>default/files/2020-10/Victorias-roadmap-for-reopening-How-we-live-in-metropolitan-Melbourne-FINAL.pdf</u>) when we reach the next milestone without new infections, we will be able to open up the church for 9:15 and 11am with various safety protocols. Given that we want everyone to be able to return to worship at the same time, the 8am, 1pm and 5pm services can resume once the larger services are possible and advisable.

There are no easy ways at present for any of our church groups or rental groups to meet in the church building.

We are one congregation; we reconfirm that until we can meet without restricting numbers, we will continue to live stream worship.

Worship Service translations into your own language

Did you know YouTube offers an option to translate our Sunday morning worship into your own language?

Using your **computer**, follow these instructions to view the service with subtitles/captions in the language of your choice.

(Please note these instructions are not applicable for viewing on your TV, tablet or phone).

- 1. Go to the GWUC YouTube channel <u>https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCiWX-WVai6wcQ9pLxon1Geg</u>
- 2. Select the service you would like to watch;
- 3. Click on the Settings icon at the bottom right of the service you have selected;



4. Click on the *Subtitles/CC* option, and then choose *English (auto-generated)* to turn captions on.



 Click on the Subtitles/CC > English (auto-generated) option again and then select Auto-translate. This will bring up a list of languages for you to choose from.



- 6. Select your language of choice.
- Now simply click the play button to resume watching the service. You will hear the English version of the service and will see subtitles across the bottom of the screen in the language you chose.

Please note: The *Subtitles/CC* option is **not** offered if you are watching our services live. The language translation process can sometimes take a couple of days to complete. If the *Subtitles/CC* option is not available on your first attempt, please try again later.
