Church Council News

As Victoria is slowly returning to 'normal', Church Council are hopeful that we can begin the process to return to normal church activities over the next couple of months.

A first step was live music returning to worship, and the church office will be returning to onsite from 1 December 2020. As most groups would usually be wrapping up at this time of year, the complex will remain closed for meetings. **Online worship will continue throughout December.**

Included with this bulletin and email is a document "*Guidelines for a return to onsite worship*" which shares with you a limited opportunity for attendance at upcoming services with certain guidelines in place. These guidelines are based on both government and Synod restrictions and we hope will allow for a smooth transition back to worship, while keeping our church and our congregation safe.

We look forward to announcing more changes as restrictions ease.

Holy Communion - Sunday 29 November

In accordance with UCA Assembly guidelines for live streaming of communion the Church Council have approved communion to be celebrated as part of the live stream services. The next communion service will be held on Sunday 29 November. Some may prefer not to have communion at home as part of the service and that choice is respected. For those wishing to share in communion please have ready a small amount of bread (enough for those present) and some juice or water or appropriate drink so that you are ready to share in communion together as an online community of faithful disciples of Jesus.

Check-In Thursday with Neil - Thursday 3 December @ 10am

Remembrance Services - *a time to remember those who are no longer with us.*

Based on current Government restrictions, we are planning to hold two identical services this year on Tuesday 8 December and Wednesday 9 December at 8pm. The service on Tuesday 8 December will also be available to view online on our YouTube channel (www.gwuc.org.au/live).

If you are attending onsite, we do ask that you only attend one service. Having two identical services on two separate evenings, should allow for all individuals and families to attend within the capacity limits of our church buildings.

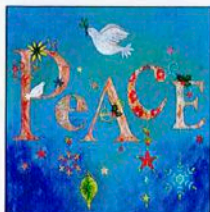

Sentiment: May the joy and peace of Christmas be yours throughout the year.



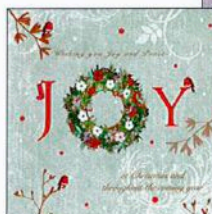
4 Dove

Guidelines for a Return to onsite worship...

As restrictions are beginning to ease in Victoria, the Church Council of Glen Waverley Uniting Church are hopeful that a return to normal church activities will be possible over the next couple of months. We encourage you to continue to engage with our online worship and are pleased to be able to offer a limited opportunity for attendance at upcoming services with certain guidelines in place.

These guidelines are based on both government and Synod restrictions and we hope will allow for a smooth transition back to worship, while keeping our church and our congregation safe.

To allow you to make an informed decision about your own return to church activities, we have listed here the guidelines which currently apply to Glen Waverley Uniting Church. As government and Synod restrictions are amended, so too will these guidelines.

If you are not able to access the online services or feel the need to attend in person, please contact the church office (*see over for contact details*).

We look forward to a time when we will again be sharing services as a whole community.

From **Sunday 6 December**, a limited number of worshippers will be able to attend the church for worship services. As this number may change over time, we ask that you contact the church office to register your interest for each service. This will also assist in contact tracing should the need arise.

If you are in attendance the guidelines are:

- Face masks are to be worn at all times (*especially while singing*).
- Good hand hygiene must continue to be followed.
- Any gathering before or after the service will need to be outside. Gathering in the foyer/fellowship area is not permitted.
- Food or drink must not be shared. *Please note: GWUC Kitchen is closed except for refilling of your own water bottle.*
- Please bring your own hymn books and bibles if you wish to use these.
- Physical distancing (1.5m) must still be observed. Seating has been clearly marked to meet social distancing compliance, and only members of the same household will be able to sit together.
- 1 person per 4 sqm rule currently applies, which significantly limits our capacity.
- Registration of attendance is to be completed (*handwritten list or QR code*).
- The toilets are open and are professionally cleaned regularly.

As our live broadcast begins before 10am those attending will be asked to remain quiet in the worship space for 5 minutes before the service starts during the organ prelude, and to remain seated after the service until the organ postlude is ended. Following this, you will be asked to move outside rather than gather in the foyer.

As always, if you or a member of your household are unwell you must not attend.
