Worship Services - February 2021

The reasons include the current uncertainties and the fact that the numbers presently attending physically in the church mean that we can currently accommodate all those who choose to attend the 10am service. Should the situation change the decision will be reviewed.

Masks & Covid Safe Guidelines

Masks must be carried at all times, and are once again **mandatory** to wear while inside the church buildings.

A reminder also that the foyer/fellowship areas should not be used for gatherings and should be kept as clear as possible. If you wish to catch up with others please move outside to do so.
