### Face to face worship, vaccination and discernment

It is slowly becoming clearer how worship services, and other activities, will be permitted to function after we reach 80% of 16+ being fully vaccinated. The Victorian government is strongly committed to only allowing large indoor gatherings, including church, if all attendees 16+ are vaccinated. For GWUC, the Victorian government roadmap means that 73 people may attend worship if all those attending who are 16+ are fully vaccinated, or just 20 can attend if unvaccinated or vaccination status is unknown. No end date has been set for this arrangement. It is now clear that proof of vaccination will be primarily by attaching a certificate from Medicare to the updated Service Victoria (Check-in) app. Some instructions can be found at <a href="http://wiki.gwuc.org.au/gwuc/CovidVaccinationCertificate">http://wiki.gwuc.org.au/gwuc/CovidVaccinationCertificate</a>. A paper copy will be acceptable.

Please seriously consider getting vaccinated if you have not done so already. The purpose of these restrictions is to maintain people's health and safety. This will not be easy for church or business. The Moderator of the Synod of Victoria and Tasmania, Rev Denise Liersch, wrote to our community about this process of discernment during the week. (click here). Next week Church Council will be deliberating on how we can re-open under these conditions. Please pray for their meeting.

Due to the current lockdown in Melbourne, our church complex is closed. All meetings and events planned until late October have been cancelled. 10am Live Stream Worship services will continue to be held each Sunday.
