*Congregation members are welcome to attend the 10am service from Sunday 7th November. All attendees must be fully vaccinated, and masks must be worn indoors.* 



The Church Council has decided that from Sunday 7 November, and for the foreseeable future, there will be one 10am morning worship service each Sunday. Congregation members will be able to attend and the service will continue to be live streamed. As we have to apply the 4 square metre rule, we will be able to have up to 73 people attending, but those who attend must be **fully vaccinated** (children under 16 initially covered by parent's vaccination status). A Pastoral Letter has been distributed which explains the Church Council's decision in more detail. Please click here to read your copy.

Please Check-In upon your arrival using the QR code displayed at all entrances. A *Check-In Marshal* will also need to verify your vaccination status. This is required by the government and is important for everyone's safety.

The church office will return to onsite from Wednesday 3 November, and the buildings will re-open for church groups and hirers from Monday 8 November.

Please be aware that gathering, capacity and density limits currently still apply, and masks are required to be worn indoors. All doors and windows should be open to allow natural airflow, and ceiling fans must not be used.
