The opportunities of this group include:

- * Supervising the allocation of fete money through the Congregational Outreach Projects.

- * Supporting and encouraging members of the congregation in pursuing their outreach passions. Examples have included Tanks for Timor, flood reconstruction, Habitat for Humanity, Kid's Hope and Material Aid offerings.

- * Liaising with the Uniting Church Justice and International Mission cluster, which "works with congregations and social justice networks to shift and shape public policy towards a fair and just world."

- * Support and oversight of ongoing outreach style groups, including Asylum Seeker Support Group, the Fete, the Eco group and pancake breakfasts at the high school.

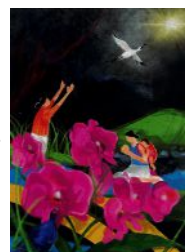
