Key learnings from Intercultural Bible Study To build up cultural intelligence (CQ)

With 10 sessions of Bible studies we had opportunities to explore our own cultural stories through movies and drama clips, as well as learning from Biblical figures' cross-cultural faith journey. As we learned different definitions between Social and Theological approaches to cultural issues, following 7 key learnings from our sessions will help us continue to build up our Cultural Intelligence(CQ).

Seven Key Learnings when you cross boundaries

- 1. Listen to God's calling
- 2. Leave your comfort zone support system, biases
- 3. Communicate without presumption
- 4. Build relationship with mutual respect
- 5. Be the blessing to others
- 6. Pursue the truth submerge yourself into God
- 7. Trust God and be yourself (From Intercultural Bible study 2023 Glen Waverley UCA) 7. Be patient.

Cultural Intelligence (CQ)

The concept of Cultural Intelligence was introduced by Professors Christopher Earley and Soon Ang in 2003. Cultural Intelligence is also known as Cultural




Quotient (CQ), which is derived from IQ. Earley and Ang defined Cultural Intelligence as the ability to adapt to new cultural settings. People with high CQ aren't experts in every kind of culture. Instead, they have the skills to go into new environments with confidence, and to make informed judgments based on observations and evidence.

10 ways to develop Cultural Intelligence (CQ)

- 1. Understand your own cultural background.
- 2. Make an effort to learn about other cultures.
- 3. Seek out opportunities to interact with people from other cultures.
- 4. Try to become more aware of your own cultural biases and assumptions.
- 5. Be open-minded.
- 6. Be flexible.
- 8. Communicate effectively.
- 9. Focus on building relationships.
- 10. Learn a new language.
