Sammy Stamp

Have you ever wondered what happens to the used stamps which are collected by the church office? Sammy Stamp was started over 100 years ago by the Presbyterian Women's Missionary Union and later taken over by the Uniting Church. The guidelines say that funds will be used for the relief of suffering whether physical, emotional, spiritual or economic, for the betterment of people who in turn will be able to influence the health and well-being of their immediate or extended community. Stamps are collected from the office and helpers from our church trim and sort according to direction. A dedicated group of volunteers gather at a church hall in Brighton where stamps are further sorted and buyers from overseas and local dealers come. For the 2024 year up to 19th November, sales reached over \$28,850. So keep saving stamps - every little bit helps!

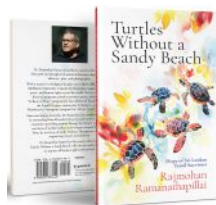
