
HELP NEEDED - Pancakes at GWSC




UCAF

As you know, our current Welfare Coordinator, Ray, will be leaving at the end of February, and we are seeking to recruit another Welfare Coordinator who will work with Faye McDougall and we will update you on our progress.

In addition, we are seeking expressions of interest from volunteers from our congregation to meet with clients to provide pastoral care, referrals and food distribution. Volunteers would be people who are comfortable dealing with people from all different walks of life and backgrounds, who enjoy talking to people and listening to their stories. We are seeking several people who could contribute and regularly commit to a couple of hours each week and would appreciate expressions of interest in providing assistance and support. Friday 28 February. We will be setting up the tables from 9:00am. Books will be sorted and displayed from 10:00am. This is a mammoth task which


will be ongoing for most of the day, so we would really appreciate your help. Come when you can and there will be a job for you! Thank you to those who have already volunteered.
