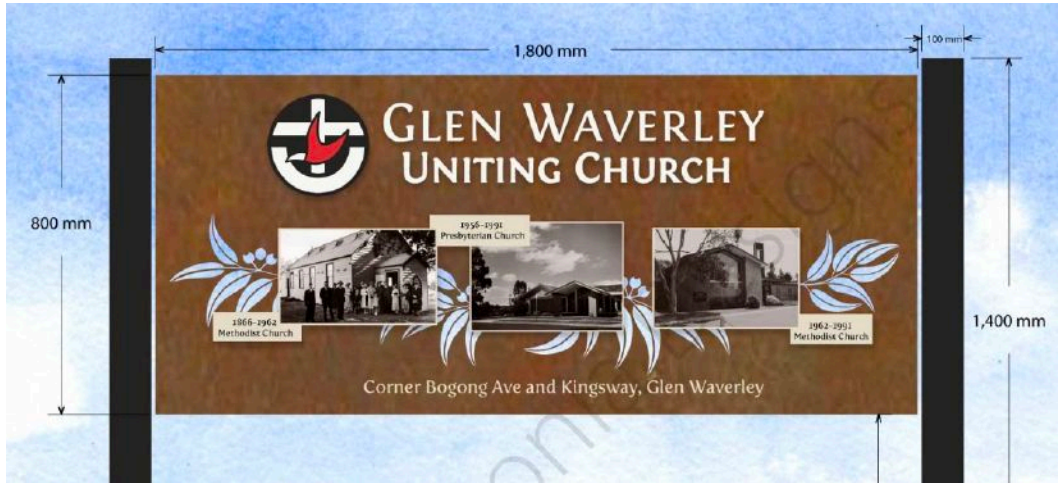

Bogong Avenue Carpark

A reminder that the Bogong Avenue Carpark is now open. Parking is free, however some time restrictions apply.



Sunday: all day parking, all levels.

Monday to Saturday: 8am to 8pm. Ground to Level 4 is **2-hour** parking and Levels 5+6 is **4-hour** parking. (Level 7 is council staff parking.) The carpark is regularly monitored by parking officers, so please take careful note of any signage and restrictions that apply.

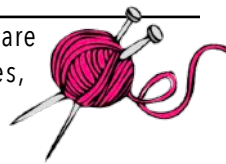
