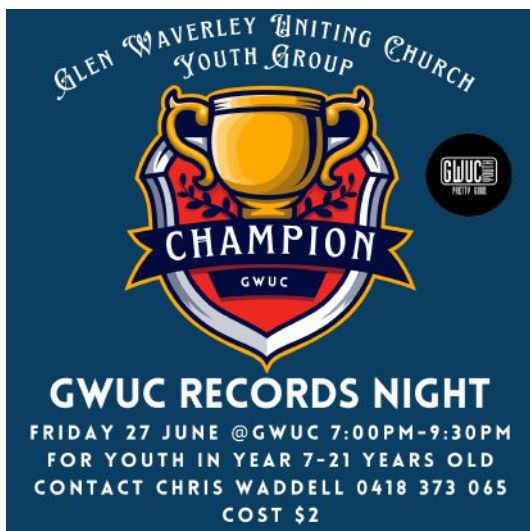

June Material Aid - GWUC Welfare Pantry
