Responses to Outreach Committee

- **limit the number of applicants**

- **ensure projects can be completed**
- **12 to many but no limits on the number**
- **Simplify the process**

6.a. Projects should be chosen to reflect a balance between Local Community, State or National Community, and Global Community

Community, and Global Community projects.

Balance may be defined over the number of projects, or over the amount of funding of the projects, at the discretion of the committee.

6 b. Preference has been given in the past to new projects, but there is now a feeling that we should be looking at

a feeling that we should be looking at building continuing relationships with previously supported projects.

(CC minute 03/2010) Therefore, a balance between ongoing projects and new projects or one off projects desirable.

4.8. The congregation recognizes that the COP Committee works on their behalf and at times may need to

their benefit and at times may need to make difficult choices.

The projects recommended for support are to be those that are most likely to achieve a full and successful outcome from the receipt of COP funds. Some projects may not be funded to ensure successful projects are able to be completed.
