Thank you for your letter of call from the Glen Waverley Uniting Church congregation, and the sense of joy and expectation with which the recommendation from the Joint Nominating Committee was received.

I am delighted to accept the placement as Minister of the Word in the Glen Waverley congregation helping the congregation give expression to the vision of a faithful, Christ-centred community, meeting God and sharing God's unconditional love.
