### 2. NOTES from initial meeting held 20 Sept 2023,

As recorded in GWUC wiki - <u>CouncilAgenda20231016</u> > <u>CouncilMinutes20231016</u>

- <u>MargaretFraser</u>, <u>DavidMorgan</u> and <u>AnnetteWojak</u> met to reconstitute the <u>Outreach</u> <u>Committee</u> with <u>VidaFoo</u>.
- The group would like to propose a formal name change from Community Outreach Missional Group to Outreach & Social Justice Missional Group.
  - This more closely aligns with the Justice & International Mission group (JIM) in Synod, and with the interests of the group.
  - $\circ$  Revitalising the wiki presence is waiting on approval for that name change.
- Foci seen by the group include:
  - Keeping the notice board current.
  - Reviving the Material Aid collections.
  - Communicating the JIM materials with the congregation, including seasonal items.
  - Communicating information on COP projects to congregation and wider community.

### 3. ACTIONS ARISING from 20 Sept 2023 meeting

- **3.1 Name change** approved by Church Council. we are now "Outreach and Social Justice Mission Group", referred to as OSJC.
- **3.2 Update of notice board –** by Margaret and Annette. We have
  - removed old and irrelevant items,
  - removed the word "Community" and added the words "Social Justice" to the existing "Outreach"
  - Publicised the recipients of the Fete proceeds, and the amounts donated to each, with thanks given to the congregation
  - Featured the current Material Aid project/s, eg Share the Dignity, Welfare, empty Christmas Tree with items going to Broadmeadows.
  - Featured Christmas projects, such as Christmas Bowl, other charities such as Tearfund and UnitingWorld offering "Useful Gifts" such as goats and chickens and the Shoebox project which our 5pm service group organized.
- **3.3** Bulletin and Kingsway items items were added for Oct, Nov and Dec to advise about new committee, Material Aid, and inviting new project ideas and new committee members. Trying to encourage new ideas and all-age and all-service involvement.
- **3.4 Material Aid collections -** Annette has volunteered to organise this. Very positive responses to November "Share the Dignity" (approx 20 handbags) and December

"Empty Christmas Tree" appeals. Investigating Harvest Festival idea for March. Considering an annual calendar of projects, noting Neil Peters' list of past recipients.

Is this something that would have belonged to the Outreach & Social Justice Missional Group, and if so can you confirm and follow up in some way possibly formally closing it down so that the database can be updated?

### 5.5 Mission and Scope of the Outreach and Social Justice Committee (OSJC) -

- a. Is the following draft suitable as a description of the OSJC?
  - supporting social justice, international, national and community projects outside of GWUC, and including our Congregational Outreach Projects,
  - encouraging members to pursue their outreach and social justice passions

b. In the absence of an active OSJC for some time, some individuals and groups have continued to work faithfully with or without support from the appropriate Mission Group. Who belongs where? In particular, who should OSJC be supporting? This may require sensitive discussion with other established Mission Groups and individuals within GWUC so that we work within the agreed framework.

Could we request Church Council to sort this out so that all groups/projects can be included, supported and monitored under the appropriate Mission Group, as was intended in our 2009 On the Way Together restructure and the Church New Structures 2013V2 document. There will inevitably be some blurred lines and we don't want to discourage any existing efforts.
