

# Parking Changes in Glen Waverley Activity Centre

June 2023

## Attention: Glen Waverley Activity Centre traders and trader parking permit holders

Monash Council will soon begin the extension of Bogong Car Park in Glen Waverley to add four additional floors and more than 500 additional car parking spaces.

Bogong Car Park will be unavailable during construction, which will start in late July and be completed by early 2025. During this time, we will be making changes to on-street parking restrictions in the surrounding streets to accommodate people who visit and work in Glen Waverley.

Traders, residents, and visitors will be able to park in the new parking restriction areas, with parking permits required to be displayed if you plan to stay longer than the allowed time.

These changes mean **you may not be able to park where you are currently parking**, and you will need to use the map included with this letter to find alternative parking. Importantly, there are no changes to the restrictions in the Euneva West Car Park.

## What we are changing

### Euneva Carpark Multi Level

Level 6 will be made available for permit holders. Signage in the area will also direct casual users, shoppers, and diners to use Euneva Car Park.

### On Street Parking Changes

A map of the changes to the parking arrangements is shown on the other side of this letter to help you understand your parking options. The main change is the provision of a new **2P 8am-8pm, Authorised Vehicles Exempted**, with some existing restrictions also being updated to **2P, 8am-8pm**.

Traders **must** display a permit in the vehicle to park in the **2P** restriction.


