


Raising GWUC's profile by serving our local community

0.3 pastoral care


- Community building

Full time or two part time roles


- Providing opportunites to recognise and strengthen personal faith

"The Glen Waverley Uniting Church Congregation requests Port Phillip East Presbytery to extend the placement of Alanee Hearnshaw for up to five years"


Rationale:
