- \* The possible merging of the 9.00 and 11.00 am worship was discussed but a decision was deferred to enable consultation with the congregations.
- \* All the COP funds for 2009 (\$26,000), including the excess, have now been paid to the intended recipients. See 'thank you's' on the Notice Board.
- \* Community Outreach Missional Group is being asked to co-ordinate the 2010 COP.

## **Outreach Missional Group**

We have formally agreed to call ourselves the **Outreach Missional Group**, and for clarity we prefer the full title to be used.

This month's report include news of three groups:

- 1. **Our three Playgroups**, currently involving 40 children from about 35 families, have enrolments continuing. Assistance from GWUC members with maintenance has helped to improve the outdoor facilities.
- 2. With the success of their application for a Permanent Resident Visa, our **Asylum Seeker** guests in the manse have been required to move out to make way for new tenants. We have assisted them in finding new accommodation which they will take up on 26-7 March. If anyone with a trailer or van can assist in the move it would help greatly (contact Robin Pope 9561 7021). We will be welcoming new tenants shortly after that time.
- 3. GWUC will host a dinner on 25 March in support of the **National Close the Gap Day 2010**, aimed at raising awareness of the Indigenous health crisis, and to call on our governments to improve health services (with the associated problems of housing, employment and education) by building Indigenous control and participation in the delivery of services. You are invited to show your support by attending a Dinner at 5.30 pm on 25 March (cost \$10). More details are on the posters around the Church. sign up on the list outside the Church Office!

## APPOINTMENT OF ELDERS
