Did you miss last week's church service—

Would you like to watch it at home?

As an extension of our broadcast ministry to Beeac, we are now able to offer you a limited opportunity to watch the current church service as a delayed broadcast in your own home (if you have the internet).

If you log on to the GCWUC web site, and go to the 'video' option (<http://gwuc.orkg.au/index.php/videos/>) and follow the on-screen instructions, you will be able to watch the previous week's broadcast service at home at anytime that suits you between **7.30 am and 11.30 pm Monday to Saturday**. Only one person at a time can use the facility at this stage.

Please note that it is a large file, and will use around 400mb of your internet data allowance. You must have the latest version of *Quicktime* installed and links on the church web site will help you. I recommend that you use a computer that is less than 5 years old.
