2011 "SAMMY STAMP'S" EXCELLENT YEAR

I am pleased to report that sales, up to and including December 8th, 2011 reached \$32,399.55 (last year \$23,747). This is the second highest amount raised for a year since Sammy's formation in 1977 (\$33,256 in 2006). Sales since 1977, now total \$613,341.

Congratulations and sincere thanks to all the volunteers who attend regularly on Thursday and also all the extra work you do for the UCAF Stamp Fund's ministry at home and in the community. (Average attendance this year 21.1 from a pool of about 40 people).

The Sammy Stamp DVD has been popular, around 25 requests in 2011. I spoke at nine locations at which I showed the DVD at six. (Eight talks were presented in 2008, four in 2009 and five in 2010).

Here follows a list of grants approved by the Sammy Stamp team, totalling \$32,020.70 during 2011 (last year \$22,800). This was the second highest yearly total since 1977.

ELDERS' ROSTERS

The Elders' rosters are now allocated automatically. Each week, a computer program works out who should next be rostered at the end of a three month period, and adds those people to the end of the roster. In this way, the roster will always show who is rostered for the next three months, and you can plan ahead on that basis.

Note that the roster is now split into two parts - the next month (4 week period), and the following two months (8 week period). The first part will be published each week on the Office Notice Board (instead of in the Weekly Bulletins), and is regarded as **DEFINITIVE** (that is, no changes will be made by the computer). If you find that you need to swap a rostered duty during this time, IT WILL BE YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO ARRANGE A SWAP (as it always has been).

On the other hand, the second part of the roster is to be regarded as **TENTATIVE** - that is, it may change before it gets published as definitive.

What might change it?

Any elder may update their "unavailable" status for a rostered duty during this second period, and that unavailability will be taken into account when the roster program runs each week.

Please note that for this system to work, you must make your availability and preferences for roster duties known. Contact John Hurst or David Morgan for assistance.
