Lorel Thomas from the Australian Network to ban land mines and cluster munitions will speak on this important issue. The network is an advocacy group working to eliminate the use of these indiscriminate killing devices and to ameliorate the after effects.

Lorel has been a lead advocate to the Australian Government pressuring it to pass legislation to ban these. She was recently mentioned and thanked in Parliament for the work she and others had done resulting in the passing of the "Cluster Munitions Act" (part of the Crimes Act).

She has also recently returned from an International Conference in Oslo of the meeting of treaty nations and NGOs fighting this cause. There she launched a book produced by the Australian network called "In Search of Safe Ground".

Lorel has agreed to talk on the global problem of these weapons, where they are, the problems and the progress. She will talk about the Australian Legislation, the launch of the book and a project in East Cambodia.
