Nadrasca Community Farm could be forced to leave its current location at Morack Road, Vermont and to cease its operations in providing day services for adults with intellectual and physical disabilities, adversely affecting organisations like Yooralla, Scope, Melba Support Services, Heatherwood School and Alkira.

The petitioners are requesting that the Legislative Council of Victoria urge the Government to facilitate an affordable arrangement that will guarantee Nadrasca Community Farm will remain in its current location so it can continue to provide great service to the community and grow.
