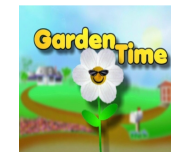


ONLY 2 WEEKS TO GNUC GRAND FETE

In the past years very few of the donated vouchers have sold for their full face value - bidders are after bargains!. We are very lucky if we average 60-70% of face value. However there are a number of vouchers which we believe could be used by congregation members as part of their normal expenditures.. For example a Coles \$50 gift voucher could be used as part of normal grocery shopping. If the Gift Card is purchased at the Silent Auction for \$50 the nett cost to the purchaser is zero, but the fete profits are increased by probably \$15 or more.
