My name is Rakesh. I am a minister with the Church of North India in the Eastern Himalayas, and I believe that God changes the world.

I minister in one of the most remote regions of my country. The people here come from many different ethnic groups and live in difficult circumstances. Some are among the poorest, most marginalised people in my country. Men, women, girls and boys: when they hear the good news of Christ, they are full of hope! They hear that they are loved. They discover new meaning and purpose in their lives.

Many families ask to be baptised and they are eager to learn more. How does Jesus want them to live? What encouragement does the

Bible provide? How do they build communities of peace and justice? Who will teach them how to be followers of Christ?

My colleagues and I pack our belongings into small bags and travel hundreds of kilometres to our congregations. We walk, we use trailbikes, we even swim rivers, to reach places where Christians are desperate for teaching and pastoral care.

But we don't have anywhere near enough leaders or resources to nurture the church and help transform our communities.

My story is echoed throughout the world:

- · Young leaders working with vulnerable youth in Zimbabwe
- Pacific women seeking ordination
- Ministers guiding the burgeoning church in China, or working on the front line of climate change in the Pacific.

Together, we're strengthening our growing, global church
