Call for Volunteers - Can you help?

As our worship services have returned to normal and most groups are meeting face-toface, we are now aware, more than ever, that some of our congregation members have decided to take a break from rosters. Some of these people have volunteered for many years over many rosters. To you all, we say a huge THANK YOU. Your service has been greatly appreciated.

However, this now means there are a few holes in previously full rosters, and we are looking for others to fill these gaps to enable the smooth running of our Sunday services and church complex. Can you help?

You will usually only be on a roster 3 or 4 times a year, but it can be more or less if you prefer. We are currently needing volunteers for:

Door stewards - welcoming people to church, handing out bulletins or relevant papers, taking the offering bowls forward, directing people to empty seats (if required) - these people remain at the rear of the church to assist any latecomers - 9.15am or 11am. *Pam Graham* 9561 5871

Vestry stewards (Prayers of the People) either live or recorded - prepare and read Prayers of the People during worship services, offer prayers before the service for the worship team (held in the Vestry). Some Prayers of the People are supplied by the worship leaders, others may be written by you - 9.15am or 11am. *Church office 9560 3580*

Communion stewards - assist in distribution of communion during services, setup before service and clean up after - 9.15am or 11am. *Faye Wagon 8740 3529*

Participation is an important part of belonging to a community and there is something for everyone!
