## Church Worship Area Heating

We have received a number of questions on the church heating from last week.

During this time of COVID, with air flow requirements we need to have the windows and/or doors open, and when the days are extremely cold, the church heating struggles. Last week it was only 5° outside during 9:15am worship and 7° during 11:00am worship.

The system extracts air from both inside and outside, circulating it to raise the temperature. With all the cold air continuously coming in, it found it very hard last week, leaving us all feeling just cold air moving around.

At 11:00am worship we tried to help the system cope by using the old ceiling heating units, but as they take 30-40 minutes to get to temperature, it was not until late in worship the room felt warmer. We will try that approach earlier in coming weeks to help.

We encourage everyone to wear masks as we are being asked to do, rug up and sing enthusiastically!

During the COVID lockdown we were unable to process donations for asylum seekers through the boxes located in the church foyer. David Spitteler, who has been providing the outlet for these donated goods in Dandenong, has now moved to a smaller location where he is only able to distribute food and some hygiene items. Any donations of clothing, household linen, or small household goods should now be directed either to the large charity bins in the church carpark, or taken to Eastern Emergency Relief (who also accept donations of furniture for use by those in need). Specific donations which are welcomed are: 750ml vegetable or canola oil; tinned mackerel; tinned fruit - tropical varieties; all varieties of spice; pickles/chutney; soap; toilet rolls; tissues; razors.
