Updated COVIDSafe advice...

Medical forms

From time to time, people become unwell at worship or during other church functions. Some people carry small cards which give their details and numbers for close contacts but others do not carry this information. Contact details and other information changes from time to time. We want to keep our records up to date so that we can be a safe church and give assistance when it is needed.

In the next few weeks, a member of the Inclusive Community Committee will ring you and complete your emergency form, with you. If you are not willing to complete the form over the phone, we can deliver or send it to you and arrange for it to be collected. You may want to place the form in an envelope, if it is being collected. As the information is confidential, we will store it securely in the church office, so that the Ministry Team will have access as required during emergencies. The old forms that have been kept in the safe, will be shredded.

We would like to finish updating the forms by the middle of September.
